



Examination Rules & Regulation

- Students have to maintain minimum 80% attendance overall or unit-to-unit exam to appear in every examination. In case of medical reason, up to 10 % additional attendance of total absentia will be considered.
- Department will conduct unit wise examination as per schedule given in academic calendar and one week before, each examination schedule will be informed to students.
- Examination may be in the different format as per the subject and convenience of the subject coordinator (i.e. multiple choice, one-liner, situation based, case study, group discussion, descriptive, presentation, seminar, practical, viva, etc.)
- Marks and examination time may vary according to type of examination.
- Students have to fill all types of examination forms before due date. After that, he/she will not eligible to fill the exam form.
- Students must have to clear final (semester end) theory examination with 35% of total marks of exam.
- Final practical examination will be conducted after theory exam. Each student has to perform practical. Semester 5th & 6th practical viva will be conducted by internal/external examiners. Schedule may change due to availability of external examiners.
- Students' college ID card, hall ticket, proper dressing and fees paid are compulsory for all examinations.
- Students have to read college notice boards/whatsapp groups and LJP website for circulars.

CA (Continuous Assessment): Marks will be given on the basis of attendance, assignment submission, behaviour during the semester in particular subject.

ESE (End Semester Examination): It will be descriptive and students have to secure minimum 35% (18 marks) to pass the particular subject.

TW (Term Work): Marks based on practical performance (during semester + final) and students have to secure minimum 50% marks to pass the particular practical subject.

PV (Practical Viva): Marks based on continuous lab performance and final practical viva. Students have to secure minimum 50% marks to pass the particular practical subject.

- ❖ If student is failing in either ESE or TW or PV or any two or all, he /she will declare fail in that particular subject.
