Our Mission

History

This initiative is based on an idea that came through a random incident. Three girls of LJIET were passing through the college outskirts and noticed some children were playing and asked them about their studies. They found that the children were lacking some educational facilities which is mandatory for every child of their age group. The three girls came with an astounding idea of trying to provide those educational facilities to these children. They decided to discuss this idea with their communication skills faculty, Prof. Sushma Jacob. The faculty appreciated their idea and to implement it, the students and the faculty represented their idea to the college management. The college management also appreciated the idea and provided resources to execute the idea. This way Prayas was initiated and the students of LJIET also voluntarily provided their supported by contributing their efforts.

There was a time when Prayas was about to demolish due to the lack of volunteers. But there were three volunteers who maintained the consistency & integrity of Prayas by their valuable efforts. And due to all these appreciation and efforts the Prayas is contributing towards upbringing and educating the underprivileged children since last many years (12 years).

Activities

Teaching

Prayas was initiated for upbringing and betterment of children belonging to underprivileged society by educating & fostering them. Prayas understands the importance of education and Prayas believes that it is everyone's right to gain basic education and morals. Etiquettes are set of norms one must follow in order to be gentle and decorous. Prayas not only aims to provide academic knowledge, it also encourages the of basic moral values and ethics.

Volunteers of Prayas teach the kids during the regular college days, before the college starts. They teach the kids for 1 hour during weekdays and events are conducted usually on weekends. To start with, whenever a new student is admitted to Prayas, the progress report is made of that student about how much that particular student knows and what that student needs to learn. If a student doesn't know anything and has to start with basic then volunteers of Prayas teach them digits and basic operation so atleast if they run a small shop then they can keep account of money. Different subjects are assigned to different volunteers, according to their knowledge and skills. Everyday attendance of kids as well as the volunteers is taken. Daily student progress report is being noted of each and every student.



Computer Training



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INNOVATIVE CREATIONS BAG TOP HONOURS

Nine teams of students from colleges affiliated to Gujarat Technological University (GTU) were adjudged winners under four categories at GTU Innovation Award-2016. Mirror takes a look at four innovations of the nine awarded under i-SCALE awards for start-ups and social impact and izi awards for leading innovation and solving through technology.

COLLEGE: SAL Institute of Tech & Engg Research,
LJ Institute of Engg and Tech

THE TEAM of eight students developed a mobile application that can help keep a track on a pregnancy. Designed keeping in mind increasing number of risky pregnancies in rural areas, the app was developed at the behest of Banaskantha DDO and Ahmedabad DDO and allows ASHA workers to collect data of pregnant women. The app also allows the workers keep track of the pregnant women's

medical report with instructions in Gujarati.

COLLEGE: Anand Pharmacy College

NHAT STARTED off as a college initiative to create awareness about tobacco de-addiction turned into a 3-layer program of raising awareness about de-addiction, tuberculosis and diabetes. The team has counselled nearly 200 people and helped 25 overcome tobacco addiction. They have also adopted a village near Nadiad to raise awareness of de-addiction and adopted a tiger using money collected from students, by students.

COLLEGE: G. H. Patel College of Engineering and Technology, Vallabh Vidyanagar

N 2011, a bunch of college students registered an NGO to help save child labourers. The team of students started approaching parents of these children to educate them about the requirement of basic education and also raised funds for the children. Till date, the team has got 57 child labourers enrolled in school and paid their fees ranging from Rs 2,000 to Rs 12,000 per year. The team has covered seven slums in the city and also provides tuition to 600 children in these slums. One of the kids has secured admission in a Maharashtra school.

COLLEGE: LJ Institute of Engineering and Technology

A TEAM of 45 dedicated volunteers and students reach college early on a daily basis to educate underprivileged children living in the surrounding areas. They identify children who are weak in studies and provide tuition to them to improve their skills. The eight-year-old project has seen 45 kids being educated. Apart from the academics, the children are also taught moral science, hygiene and other important habits for life.
